### JOEL REYNOLDS NAMED CALIFORNIA ATTORNEY OF THE YEAR

NRDC attorney Joel Reynolds received a California Lawyer 2009 Attorney of the Year award in the Environmental Law category for his leadership in negotiating an agreement that will permanently protect 90 percent of the majestic Tejon Ranch, the largest continuous, private landholding in California. "This was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to conserve one of California's most treasured open spaces," Reynolds said. This is the second time Joel has received the Attorney of the Year award; the first was in 2004 for his successful litigation against the U.S. Navy on Low Frequency Active Sonar.



### CHRIS KILHAM, MAY BERENBAUM KICK OFF GLOBAL GARDEN

Medicine Hunter Chris Kilham and entomologist Dr. May Berenbaum launched the first two presentations of the "Global Garden Speaker Series" designed by TalentPlus-GREEN.
